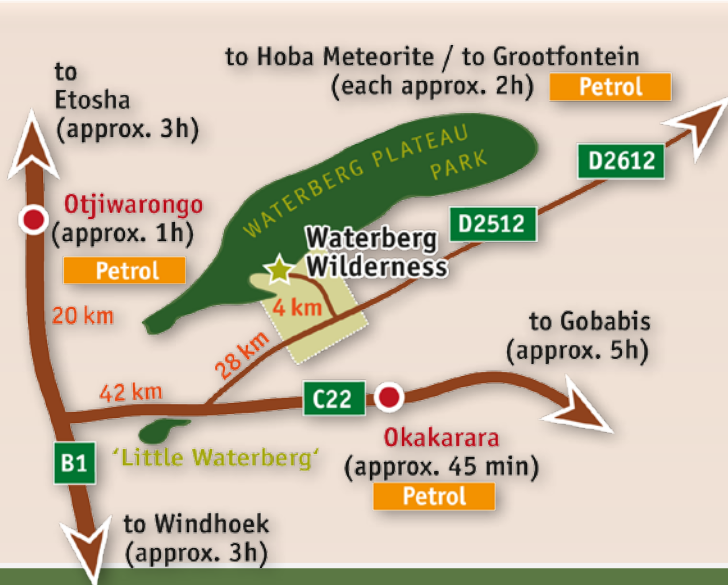

Waterberg Wilderness is a private nature reserve at the Waterberg, one of the major attractions in the northern central of Namibia – home to a unique flora, more than 200 bird species and game species such as rhino, giraffe, zebra, blue wildebeest and red hartebeest.

Experiences – Plateau Hike (8h00), "Honey-moon Sundowner" (exclusive Plateau Hike, from 15h00), Rhino Drive (from 15h00), game tracking (8h00), cultural tour to the Herero (8h00), six hiking trails incl. „Botanical Garden“ and History Path (history of the Herero).



Waterberg Plateau Lodge – on a rock terrace overlooking the bush savannah (8 double-room chalets)

Waterberg Wilderness Lodge – in an idyllic valley (8 double-rooms & 4 family rooms)

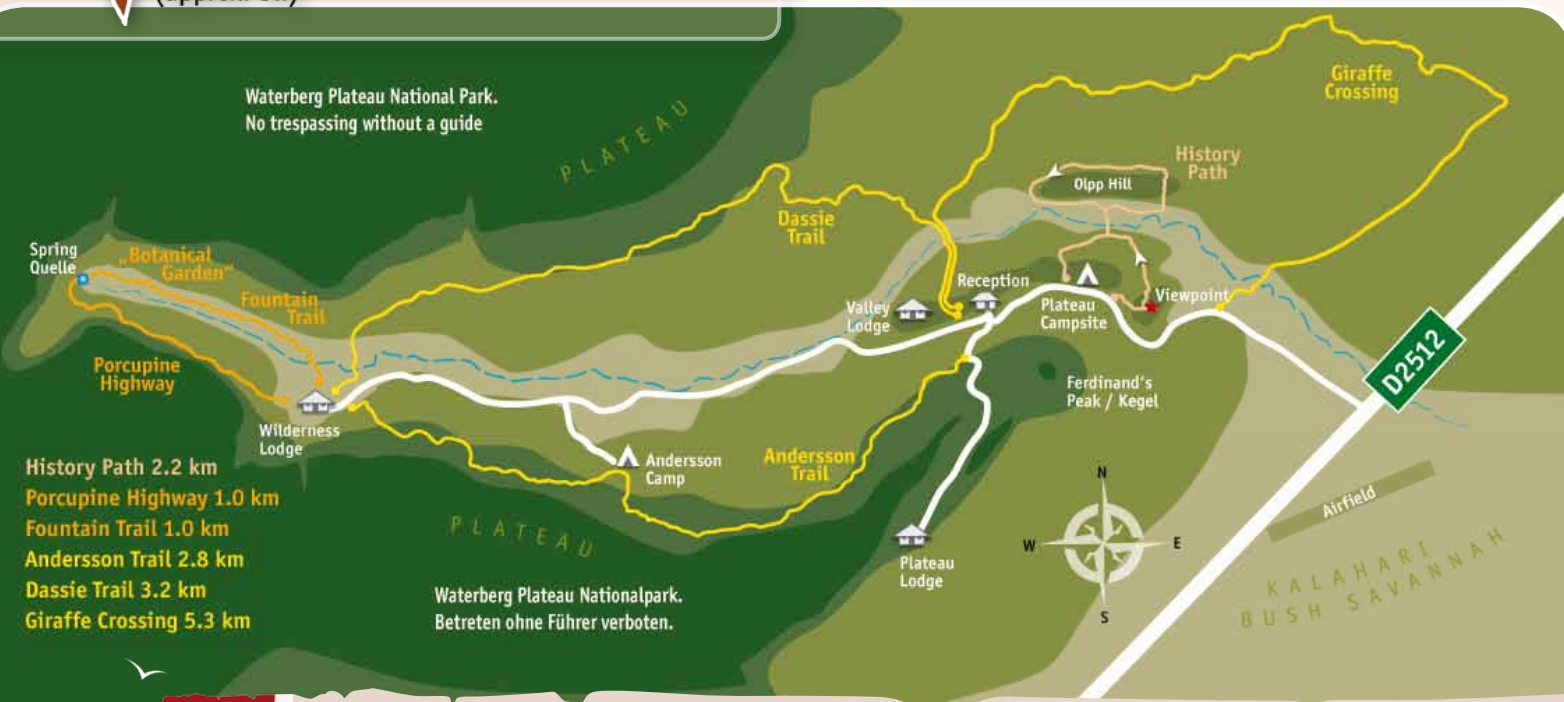
Waterberg Valley Lodge – on a hill with views over the valley (6 econo chalets)

All lodges offer a restaurant (set menu), pool, 220V electricity (solar) and free WLAN

Waterberg Plateau Campsite – on a hill in the valley (8 pitches)

Waterberg Andersson Camp – at the slope of the valley (4 pitches)

Each tent pitch has a shadow roof, table, bench, barbecue, water supply and its own shower/WC in the central ablution block. Free WLAN at the main reception
