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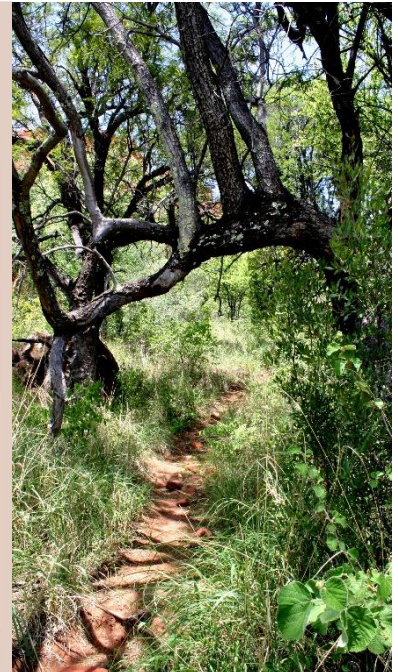
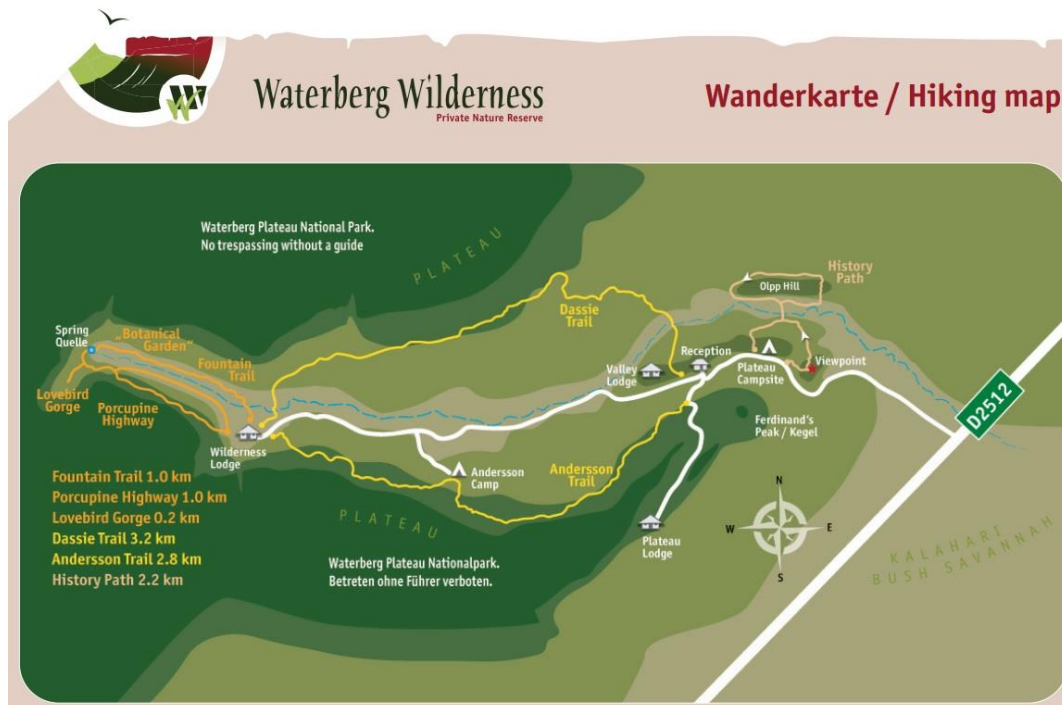
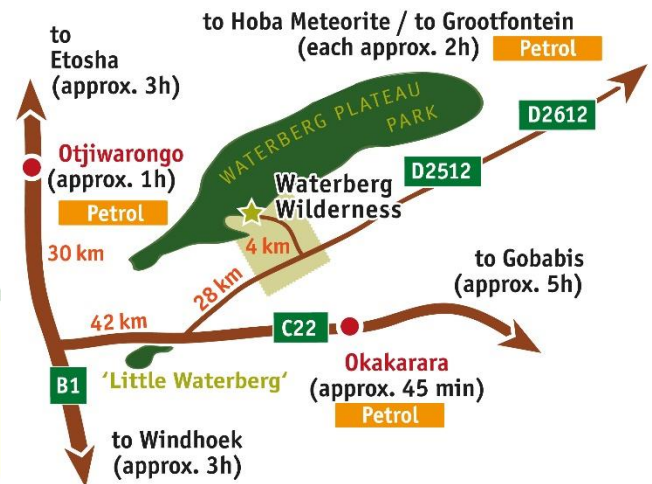

## Waterberg Wilderness...

... is a private nature reserve at the Waterberg, with access to the plateau and an open border to the Waterberg Plateau Park.

It is home to a unique flora, more than 200 bird species and game species such as white rhino, giraffe, blue wildebeest, zebra, springbuck, oryx and red hartebeest.



The Plateau is a National Park – no trespassing without a guide.

## Waterberg Wilderness – Your world of experience at the Waterberg



### Plateau Hike (8h00, 2-3 hours, moderately difficult)

Your hiking guide will climb onto the plateau with you, show you tracks of the animals and explains the traditional use of the plants along the way.

Terrific view of the valley and the endless plains of the Kalahari.



### "Honeymoon Sundowner" (16h00, 2-3 hours, moderately difficult)

Not only for Honeymooners: The exclusive Plateau Hike in the afternoon.

Have the Waterberg all to yourself and enjoy your sundowner on Mount Olympus at the edge of the Kalahari. Limited space.





### **Rhino Drive** (16h00, 2-3 hours)

Round trip through the African bush savannah at the foot of the Waterberg.

We almost always rub shoulders with rhino. With a little luck you will encounter game such as giraffe, oryx and eland, red hartebeest, blue wildebeest and kudu.



### **Rhino Tracking** (8h00, 3-4 hours, fitness is a must)

Accompany the trackers of our "Rhino Patrol" on foot in their search of the white rhinos.

Guided by your tracker you will explore our nature reserve at the foot of the Waterberg and detect game such as oryx or impala, kudu or giraffe. With a little luck you will encounter the rhinos at eye level.

**Pre-bookings for experiences** are only available for guests staying two nights or more. Guests staying for one night can only book on-site, subject to availability. Please note that children cannot participate in activities without their parents.

To **protect the rhinos** and other game from poachers, we have implemented a game fence, guarded gates on the thoroughfares, and a 'Rhino Patrol' that tracks the rhinos daily and informs our guides.

### **"Botanical Garden"** (easy, optional path moderately difficult)

With about 500 plant species, the Waterberg is regarded as one of the flora hotspots in southern Africa. On the trails to the spring at the top of the valley, small boards introduce trees and shrubs along the path.

Large display boards tell stories about the spring and two parrot species occurring at the Waterberg.



### **Nature Trails** (easy to moderately difficult)

Explore the valley of the nature reserve on your own: Demarcated paths lead through the bottom of the valley and along the slopes of the Waterberg. With a little luck, you will encounter Damara Dik Diks, kudus or rock dassies.

We recommend sturdy shoes, a hat and a bottle of water.



**Lodges:** All three lodges offer a restaurant with a bar and free WLAN (limited bandwidth), swimming pool, 220 V solar power (hairdryers & battery chargers). Rooms have a portable fan.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch snack on request, dinner: set menu (farm cuisine with hearty dishes). We recommend our Wilderness Lodge for **families**; no family units available at Plateau or Valley Lodge.



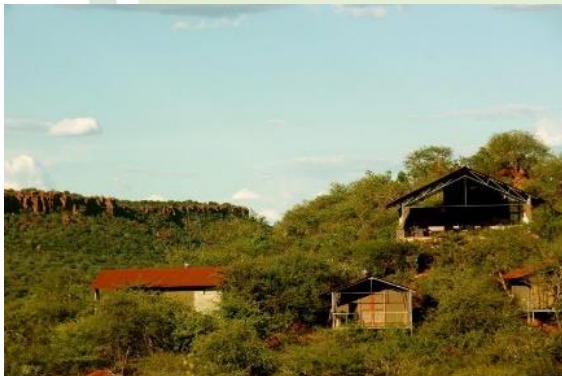
#### **Waterberg Plateau Lodge** (8 double room chalets)

Located on a rock terrace on the slope of the Waterberg, offering a view of the Kalahari bush savannah.



#### **Waterberg Wilderness Lodge** (9 double, 3 family rooms)

In the valley. Ambience of the former farm, surrounded by an idyllic garden. View to the red cliffs of the Waterberg.



#### **Waterberg Valley Lodge** (9 econo tented chalets)

Situated on a hill at the valley mouth, offering a view over the valley and to the red cliffs of the Waterberg.



**Campsites:** Each pitch has a shade roof, table, bench, barbecue, tap, own shower / toilet in the wash building. Free WLAN (limited bandwidth) in the Waterberg Valley Lodge restaurant.

Please be prepared for **self-catering**: No meals available in the restaurant when the lodge is fully booked.



**Waterberg Plateau Campsite** (16 pitches) – Located on a hill and on a slope at the valley mouth.

**W. Andersson Camp** (4 pitches) – On a slope in the valley.
